This position works with significant independence, serving as legal support for complex business issues and initiatives within CIC and the Crown sector including advising on, negotiating, preparing, reviewing and approving legal documents/contracts, providing legislative services and advice, developing responses to freedom of information requests, and providing policy and legal advice on new and emerging matters.

The candidate will demonstrate knowledge of legal and legislative principles and practices, an ability to handle complex legal issues with tight deadlines; provide research, factual information, counsel and guidance on legal questions or issues, develop and maintain effective relationships with internal and external contacts to the organization, knowledge of Government and Crown corporation structures and decision making processes; strong interpersonal, communication, negotiation, presentation and writing skills, and strong organizational and research skills with an ability to work well both independently and in a team environment.

The candidate will possess a Bachelor of Law Degree or Juris Doctor, be a member in good standing with The Law Society of Saskatchewan and have a minimum of three (3) years' experience in private practice, corporate in-house, or government legal practice.
