The Vice-President reports to the President and Chief Executive Officer and serves as a key member of CIC's executive management team. As an executive member you will embrace a one-team approach to your work within CIC and across the Crown sector and will embody our corporate values of leadership, integrity, teamwork and excellence. You will work alongside your senior management colleagues to champion the inclusion of diverse perspectives and foster an environment of continuous improvement and innovation.
